Codespear provides a multi-network, multi-channel and multi-device urgent notification, messaging, and collaboration solution, which integrates Voice and Text-Based communication. Codespear's urgent alerting solution strengthens and supplements existing emergency broadcast systems. The application sends instant alert notifications, within seconds, to citizens, students, or other at-risk groups on a variety of devices including home telephones, cell phones, pagers, PDA's, computers, SMS based cellular phones text pagers, and external E-mail addresses.

The SmartMsg Community Alert module provides a secure and reliable method for public safety administrators to notify their community of situations ranging from flood, tornado and chemical spill emergencies, to school closings and road closures.

Individuals can "opt-in" to the database by either providing information to the agency website, or by using a simple mail-in form. For targeted geographic alerting, SmartMsg Citizens Alert features a GIS-based mapping interface.
